1 [Accept-Expend State grants for food and agricultural projects.] 2 Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to 3 retroactively accept and expend three grants totaling \$6,808.90, two from the California 4 Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) and one from the California Department of 5 6 Pesticide Regulation (CDPR); for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. 7 WHEREAS, DPH's Environmental Health Section was awarded three grants; two from 8 the CDFA, including Egg Quality Control (\$3,088.90), Organic Inspection (\$1,140), and one 9 from the CDPR, Pesticide Use Reporting (\$2,580) all for the period of July 1, 2008 through 10 June 30, 2009; and, 11 12 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the CDFA and CDPR require the City to comply with the terms of three separate agreements (the "Agreements"), copies of 13 which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.______, 14 which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and, 15 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required for these grants, as funds will be used 16 for a small portion of existing positions within DPH, including two Agricultural Inspectors 17 (#3450), .06 FTE and .02 FTE, and one Industrial Hygienist (#6138) at .04 FTE; and 18 WHEREAS, Both CDFA and CDPR prohibit including indirect costs in the budgets for 19 these grants; now, therefore, be it 20 21 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend two grants from the CDFA and one from the CDPR in the total amount of \$6,808.90; and, be it 22 23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when 24 the agreement expires; and, be it 25

2	indirect costs where prohibited in the budget of two of the three Agreements; and, be it	
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
