3 **Resolution declaring April 2006 “Voter Education and Participation Month”.**

5 WHEREAS, The California Association of Clerks and Election Officials (CACEO) and
6 Secretary of State Bruce McPherson have worked as partners to encourage all eligible
7 citizens to register and vote, and;

8 WHEREAS, The Secretary of State has declared the month of April 2006 “Voter
9 Education and Participation Month” for the June 6, 2006 Primary Election, and;

10 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco supports programs to provide
11 nonpartisan information to citizens to encourage them to participate in the election process,
12 including how and when to register to vote, voting by mail, ranked-choice voting, multilingual
13 voter services, finding information about candidates and issues, locating the appropriate
14 polling place, and how to find election results on the night of the election, and;

15 WHEREAS, The Department of Elections has a Voter Outreach and Education
16 Program consistent with law that provides educational opportunities for San Francisco
17 residents about the above topics at various venues, community organizations, street fairs and
18 festivals, and high schools and colleges around the City; now therefore be it

19 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco officially endorses April as
20 “Voter Education and Participation Month” and directs the Clerk of the Board to forward a
21 copy of this resolution to the Secretary of State, and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Elections take appropriate action to
23 continue the Voter Outreach and Education Program and encourage all eligible citizens to
24 register for and vote in the June 6, 2006 Primary Election.
