

1 [Federal Funding – Community Development]

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3 **Resolution approving the 2002 Community Development Program. Authorizing the Mayor,**
4 **on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to accept and expend the City’s 2002**
5 **Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) entitlement from the U. S. Department of**
6 **Housing and Urban Development, and Program Income of \$33,722, 231 which include**
7 **indirect costs of \$160,000, and approving expenditure schedules for recipient departments**
8 **and agencies and for indirect costs.**

9 WHEREAS, Under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as
10 amended, and related Federal regulations, San Francisco is eligible to receive a Community
11 Development Block Grant; and

12 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Community Development has prepared programs
13 entitled Final Recommendations for the 2002 Community Development Block Grant, and the
14 Expenditure Schedules for an anticipated entitlement, and reprogrammed funds from prior year
15 Community Development Programs and program income generated by the Mayor’s Office of
16 Community Development and the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency as needed, up to
17 \$33,722,231; and

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19 WHEREAS, The City will receive \$25,315,000 in 2002 CDBG Program funds; and

20 WHEREAS, A Preliminary Environmental Record on the Final Recommendations has
21 been prepared; and

22 WHEREAS, The Certifying Officer shall follow procedural provisions of NEPA to make
23 certain that all projects are in compliance with the applicable federal provisions and requirements;
24 now, therefore, be it
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1 RESOLVED, That he Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the Final Proposal 2002
2 Community Development Block Grant, to accept and expend the City's 2002 Community
3 Development Block Grant Entitlement from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban
4 Development, transfer and expend reprogrammed funds from prior year Community Development
5 Programs up to \$26,238,220 and an estimated \$7,484,011 in program income generated by the
6 Mayor's Office of Community Development, the Mayor's Office of Housing and the San Francisco
7 Redevelopment Agency, and authorizes the Mayor to enter into and execute contract agreements
8 between the City and County of San Francisco and departments identified in the 2002 Community
9 Development Program; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Mayor to
11 enter into and execute a contract between the City and County of San Francisco and the San
12 Francisco Conservation Corps; be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City's Annual Salary Ordinance be amended to reflect the
14 staffing identified in the expenditure schedule; be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That indirect costs of \$160,000 have been included in this grant;

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit documentation and
17 certifications required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
