

1 [Tunnel Avenue Weight Restrictions]

3 **Ordinance amending Section 28.2 of the San Francisco Traffic Code to extend**
4 **restrictions on certain vehicles over 18,000 pounds for two blocks of Tunnel Avenue**
5 **south of Blanken Avenue.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by amending
11 Section 28.2 as follows:

12 **SEC. 28.2 RESTRICTED THROUGH TRUCK TRAFFIC**

13 It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a vehicle with unladen weight in excess
14 of 18,000 pounds upon and through Tunnel Avenue, between Blanken ~~Boulevard~~ Avenue
15 and ~~Lathrop Avenue~~ Recycle Road; and Blanken Avenue, between Bayshore Boulevard and
16 Tunnel Avenue within the City and County of San Francisco.

17 The term “vehicle” as used herein means a device by which any person or property
18 may be propelled, moved, or drawn upon a street.

19 The Department of Parking and Traffic shall place and maintain, or cause to be
20 placed and maintained, appropriate signs at such places on the restricted streets herein
21 affected and on such streets leading thereto as will, in its judgment, best serve to give
22 notice of the prohibition contained in this Section.

23 This ordinance shall not apply to:

- 24 (a) Any vehicle which is subject to the provisions of the Public Utilities Act of the State
25 of California;

1 (b) Any commercial vehicle coming from an unrestricted street having ingress and
2 egress by direct route to and from the restricted streets herein affected, when necessary for
3 the purpose of making pickups of refuse, pickups or deliveries of goods, wares and
4 merchandise from or to any building or structure located on such restricted streets, or for
5 the purpose of delivering materials or equipment to be used in the actual and bona fide
6 repair, alteration, remodeling, or construction of such restricted streets, or of any building or
7 structure upon such restricted streets for which a building permit has previously been
8 obtained;

9 (c) Any vehicle owned by a public utility while in use in the construction, installation,
10 or repair of any public utility;

11 (d) Transit vehicles operated by the Municipal Railway along a regularly scheduled
12 route;

13 (e) Any vehicle owned by the City and County of San Francisco while being used in
14 the course of official business.
