9	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
10	Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by amending Section
11	38.N., to read as follows:
12	Sec. 38.N. PARKING IN BICYCLE LANES PROHIBITED; FINES.
13	(a) No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle such that any portion of the
14	vehicle is within a marked bicycle lane. No person shall block any portion of a marked bicycle lane
15	with his or her vehicle on weekdays from the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00
16	p.m. Any person violating this section shall be subject to a fine of \$100. Any person violating this
17	section will be subject to a fine of \$50.
18	(b) Notwithstanding the above, any person who stops, parks, or leaves standing any vehicle
19	such that any portion of the vehicle is within a marked bicycle lane from the hours of 7:00a.m.to 9:00
20	a.m. and from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday shall be subject to a fine of \$100. The
21	Department of Parking and Traffic may install signs or otherwise alert motorists of this
22	prohibition and the fine.
23	(b) This Section shall not apply to vehicles engaged in emergency services including, but not
24	limited to, fire engines, police vehicles and ambulances
25	

1	(c) This Section shall not apply to public utility vehicles while such vehicles are operating,
2	maintaining, or repairing facilities of the public utility or are being used in connection with providing
3	public utility service.
4	(d) This Section shall not apply to commercial vehicles if an exemption is reasonably necessar
5	to load or unload merchandise or passengers at any hours except between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. an
6	between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.
