Resolution retroactively approving the Agreement between the San Francisco Unified School District (District) and the City and County of San Francisco for Superintendent Services for a term of October 22, 2024, through June 30, 2027, with one two-year option to extend; the District to reimburse the City \$385,000 per year for services; and authorizing the Mayor or her designee, to enter into any amendments, modifications, or extensions to the Agreement that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities, or materially decrease the benefits to the City and are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Agreement or this Resolution.

WHEREAS, Government Code, Section 53060, authorizes the San Francisco Unified School District ("District") to contract with and employ any person to furnish special services and advice in financial, economic, accounting, legal, or administrative matters if such person is experienced and competent to perform the special services required; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco ("City") has expertise in high-level public administration including experienced personnel who oversee large budgets and departments that require prioritizing delivery of services, balancing department budgets, and overseeing operational and budgetary considerations while delivering services; and

WHEREAS, The District is in the midst of a critical effort to stabilize public K-12 schools in San Francisco, including addressing concerns around a significant budget deficit, payroll and staffing, potential school closures, and other operational issues; and

WHEREAS, The District also faces an urgent need for stabilization since it is under increased State oversight and must submit a plan to the State by the end of the 2025-2026 school year to balance its budget, and, should the District fail to submit a sufficient plan to do

1	so, the State may take over the District's governance and its financial, operational, and
2	programmatic decisions; and
3	WHEREAS, On September 22, 2024, the City announced its support for the District by
4	deploying a School Stabilization Team, consisting of top City leaders and subject matter
5	experts in the areas of children, families, education, budgeting, and fiscal oversight; and
6	WHEREAS, On October 18, 2024, Superintendent of the District, Matthew Wayne,
7	tendered his immediate resignation to the District's Board of Education, which accepted his
8	resignation, leaving the District without a Superintendent during this critical time for the public
9	schools and the families they serve, and an urgent need for special services to stabilize and
10	support the District; and
11	WHEREAS, The City has authority to provide services to the District in furtherance of
12	its municipal purpose in support of the City's approximately 49,000 public school students and
13	their families, and in light of the financial support that the City provides to the District under the
14	San Francisco Charter and otherwise; and
15	WHEREAS, The City and District have reached an agreement for the City to provide
16	the District with a Superintendent, and the City desires to enter into an agreement, a copy of
17	which is on file with the Clerk of the Board in Board File No and incorporated in
18	this resolution by reference (the "Agreement"), that will enable the City to provide the special
19	services described therein to the District; and
20	WHEREAS, The City expects to designate Maria Su, who has co-led the City's School
21	Stabilization Team, as the City employee serving as the Superintendent for the initial term of
22	the Agreement; and
23	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has authority, under Section 1.101, of the
24	Charter, to approve the Agreement; now, therefore, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That all actions taken by the City with respect to the Agreement and the execution and delivery of the Agreement are approved, confirmed and ratified; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Agreement being fully-executed by all parties, the Mayor or the Mayor's designee shall provide the final Agreement to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion in the official file.
