# Brilliant Corners: Young Adult Rapid Re-housing Grant Agreement First Amendment

# Proposed Amendment Details

- **Resolution:** Approve the **first amendment** to the grant agreement between HSH and **Brilliant Corners** for **young adult rapid re-housing**.
- **Term:**
  - Current Term: July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2024
  - Amended Term: **July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2026**
- **Amount:** Increases not-to-exceed amount by **\$17,409,402** for a total not-to-exceed amount of **\$27,309,402**.

# Grant Agreement Overview

- Population served: **young adults** ages 18 to 24 **exiting homelessness**.
- **Brilliant Corners** services provided:
  - Rental subsidies
  - Housing location services
  - Housing coordination
  - Landlord liaison services
- Other agencies provide case management and other supportive services.

## Rising Up Program:

- Agreement is part of the **Rising Up initiative** to support unhoused youth.
- **Rising Up** rapid re-housing component has a unique financial assistance model.
- Young adults have a **\$27,000 total subsidy** that they can use **at their own pace** over maximum of three years to encourage careful money management.

# Program Context

- HSH has **830 units/slots of supportive housing** for young adults.
  - Includes **340 slots of rapid re-housing**.
- Agreement serves **at least 175 young adults** in rapid re-housing at any given time.
- Average monthly subsidy: **\$1,443**
- **406 young adults** served between July 2021 and June 2023.
