3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the San Francisco Recreation and Park**  
4 **Department to accept and expend a grant of \$158,101 from the San Francisco Parks**  
5 **Alliance to support various Recreation and Park Department operations for FY2012-**  
6 **2013.**

8 WHEREAS, Since 1971 the San Francisco Parks Alliance, a non-profit organization,  
9 has been a partner of, fiscal sponsor to and philanthropic benefactor of the Recreation and  
10 Park Department, supporting San Francisco's parks, open spaces and recreation programs;  
11 and

12 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Parks Alliance acts as a fiscal agent for the Recreation  
13 and Park Department, managing approximately 50 small gift funds on the department's  
14 behalf; and

15 WHEREAS, In FY2012-2013 the San Francisco Parks Alliance contributed \$158,101 to  
16 the Recreation and Park Department from these gift funds to help sustain a wide variety of  
17 activities at the department including \$23,517 to support the commemorative park bench  
18 program; \$7,265 to install dual stream trash cans at the Palace of Fine Arts; \$6,801 to fund  
19 small park maintenance projects; \$5,028 to support the Climate Action Now, Natural Areas  
20 and Parks Volunteer programs; \$21,157 to support various staff appreciation events and  
21 activities; \$66,845 to operate the 2012 Midnight Basketball program; \$14,248 to support the  
22 department's four annual community events including the holiday tree lighting and the  
23 summer play day; \$6,930 to fund recreation programs and improvements at Camp Mather;  
24 and \$6,310 to support adaptive recreation, including Camp Azure for children on the autism  
25 spectrum; and


1 WHEREAS, RPD proposes to maximize use of available Grant funds on project  
2 expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; and,

3 WHEREAS, The City recognizes the generosity of the San Francisco Parks Alliance  
4 with sincere appreciation; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Recreation and Park  
6 Department General Manager to retroactively accept and expend retroactively the grant of  
7 \$158,101 from the San Francisco Parks Alliance to support various Recreation and Park  
8 operations in Fiscal Year 2012-13; and be it


9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
10 indirect costs in the grant budget.






