WHEREAS, Fr. Vitale was a founder of the Nevada Desert Experience, which began protests at the Nevada Nuclear Test Sites and which helped bring about a moratorium on underground nuclear testing.

WHEREAS, He worked with welfare mothers in Las Vegas, and was involved in the National Welfare Rights campaign and was on the faculty of the Franciscan School of Theology as an instructor in Spirituality and the Practice of Nonviolence; and,

WHEREAS, Fr. Vitale was a founder of the international organization, Pace e Bene Center for Nonviolence, teaching the practice and principles of peace and nonviolence throughout the world; and,

WHEREAS, Last year he joined the national movement, School of the Americas Watch, in their annual protest in Fort Benning, Georgia of the U.S. Army School of the Americas.

WHEREAS, He trespassed onto the base in Fort Benning in a peaceful manner to protest this U.S. Army training school and was sentenced to a prison term of three months; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors honors Reverend Louis Vitale who has devoted over 40 years of his life to the service of others and proclaims September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2002 as Fr. Louis Vitale Day.
