AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND

RETROACTIVELY A GRANT ALLOCATION OF UP TO \$9,150,401 FOR FISCAL YEAR 1998-99 FUNDING

FROM THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR CALIFORNIA HEALTHCARE FOR

INDIGENTS PROGRAM (CHIP) FUNDS FOR MEDICAL SERVICES TO INDIGENT PERSONS, PROFESSIONAL

SERVICES, MEDICAL SERVICES CONTRACTS, MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES, FACILITIES RENTAL,

PERSONAL SERVICES, AND INDIRECT COSTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$61,210, BASED ON 14.1% OF

ADMINISTRATIVE AND FISCAL INTERMEDIARY COSTS.

WHEREAS, The State of California passed the Tobacco Tax and Health Protection Act of 1988 (Proposition 99) and its implementing legislation, including Assembly Bill 75 (Isenberg), and Assembly Bill 99 (Isenberg), and Assembly Bill 3487 (Katz); and

WHEREAS, This act and legislation makes monies available to counties to reimburse hospitals, physicians, and other providers for uncompensated care cost, for making capital improvements, and for implementing data systems; and

WHEREAS, These funds have been anticipated and are reflected in the FY 1998-99 Annual Appropriation Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, A significant part of this funding is to implement the California Healthcare for Indigents Program (CHIP) with its attendant funding; and

WHEREAS, A percentage of these CHIP funds are allowed for administrative and indirect costs; and

WHEREAS, Receipt of such funding requires a written application from the County Board of Supervisors, along with the provision of a number of assurances concerning use of such funds; and

WHEREAS, Receipt of such funds will begin following approval of the application by the State and authorization by the County Board of Supervisors and the Mayor to accept and expend such funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Department of Public Health to accept and expend retroactively California Healthcare for Indigent Program funds for Fiscal Year 1998-99 for up to \$9,150,401 that includes indirect costs in the amount of \$61,210, based on 14.1% of administrative and fiscal intermediary costs, set forth in Board of Supervisors' file number _____ and incorporated herein by reference, between the governing body of the City and County of San Francisco and the State Department of Health Services.
