6 WHEREAS, On April 6, 2009, a 6.3 magnitude earthquake hit Italy, the worst
7 earthquake in that country in three decades; and

8 WHEREAS, The L'Aquila earthquake has devastated the City of L'Aquila and 26
9 neighboring towns and cities; and,

10 WHEREAS, According to the latest reports, more than 200 lives have been lost, and
11 many structures, including Romanesque, Gothic, Baroque and Renaissance architectural
12 treasures, modern buildings, old churches and parts of medieval buildings have been
13 damaged and leveled; and,

14 WHEREAS, Residents of San Francisco and the Bay Area have family, friends and
15 other loved ones who have been severely impacted by the earthquake; now, therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED**, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby extends its
17 condolences and greatest sympathy to the people of Italy and those affected by earthquake;
18 and, be it

19 **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the City and County of San Francisco supports the relief
20 efforts established for Italy as a result of this natural disaster.


