WHEREAS, He trained as an X-Ray technician but could not get a job because they were not hiring African-Americans, and;

WHEREAS, Mr. Sauceda joined the United States Air Force, during which service he traveled to Japan and met two life-long friends, and;

WHEREAS, Upon returning to the Bay Area, he decided to go to Court Reporting School, and;

WHEREAS, Mr. Sauceda met his future wife Marge, who is from a very wellestablished Berkeley African-American family, an accomplished pianist who for many years ran a music school and taught piano, and currently does computer work for non-profit groups, and;

WHEREAS, Mr. Sauceda first worked as a court reporter in San Mateo County, then Alameda County, and for the past 20 years in San Francisco, the last 10 years of which he worked with Judge Ellen Chaitin, and;

WHEREAS, Mr. Sauceda is the past President of the San Francisco Court Reporters
Association, past President of the California Court Reporters Association, and past President
of the National Court Reporters Association; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of San Francisco commends and congratulates Carl Sauceda on the occasion of his retirement and wishes him well in his future endeavors.
