

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - State of California - Essential Access Health -
2 Comprehensive Sexual and Reproductive Health Program - \$250,000]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$250,000 from the State of California through Essential**
5 **Access Health for participation in a program, entitled “Comprehensive Sexual and**
6 **Reproductive Health Program”; retroactively approving the Grant Agreement between**
7 **the City, acting by and through the Department of Public Health, and the Essential**
8 **Access Health for the purpose of strengthening the overall quality of the California**
9 **Comprehensive Sexual and Reproductive Health program for a term of one year from**
10 **April 1, 2026, through March 31, 2027, for a total not to exceed amount of \$250,000; and**
11 **to authorize the Director of Health to enter into amendments or modifications to the**
12 **Grant agreement that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities to the City**
13 **and are necessary to effectuate the purposes of the Grant or this Resolution.**

15 WHEREAS, The State of California (CA), through Essential Access Health (EAH) as a
16 pass-through entity, has agreed to fund the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH)
17 in the amount of \$250,000 for the period of April 1, 2026, through March 31, 2027; and

18 WHEREAS, DPH proposes to use the grant funds to strengthen the overall quality of
19 the California Comprehensive Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH) program and its ability
20 to meet the needs of the community; and

21 WHEREAS, DPH plans to provide comprehensive family planning health services to
22 Family Planning clients of reproductive age to plan and space their pregnancies, to assist
23 family planning clients to take steps toward becoming fully healthy individuals by initiating
24 reproductive life planning discussions and providing preconception/inter-conception care,
25 when indicated, through March 31, 2027; and

1 WHEREAS, DPH plans to increase the community's knowledge and access to DPH
2 family planning services; and

3 WHEREAS, DPH will look to improve and maintain DPH financial systems to ensure
4 contract compliance; and

5 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

6 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received
7 the award letter on April 3, 2026, for a project start date of April 1, 2026; and

8 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
9 \$32,608; and

10 WHEREAS, The proposed Grant Agreement contained in File No. 260738, is
11 substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to
12 be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
14 in the amount of \$250,000 from the CA through EAH; and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
16 expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby retroactively approves
18 the Grant Agreement in substantially the form contained in File No. 260738; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of
20 Public Health to make any modifications to the Grant Agreement prior to its final execution by
21 all parties, that the Department of Public Health determines, in consultation with the City
22 Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of the City, do not materially
23 increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the
24 purposes of the Grant Agreement and are in compliance with all applicable laws, including
25 City's Charter; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Grant Agreement being fully
2 executed by all parties, the Department of Public Health shall submit to the Clerk of the Board
3 of Supervisors a completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. 260738; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, This requirement and obligation resides with the Department,
5 and is for purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of
6 approved Grant Agreement.
