WHEREAS, Asian Pacific Americans have long and rich history in the City and County of San Francisco and have contributed greatly to the economic, social, cultural and civic life of the City and County of San Francisco and State of California; and,

WHEREAS, This month-long celebration increases the public awareness of the contributions and needs of Asian Pacific Americans, who comprise one third of the population in the City and County of San Francisco; now, therefore, be it;

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco declares May 2003 "Asian Pacific American Heritage Month" in the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commend the work of the organization of Chinese Americans (OCA) and the Japanese Americans Citizens League (JACL) for their successful efforts from 1978 to 1990 in advocating for this annual designation.
