Section 3: Of the above appropriated amount, ~~\$176,140~~ \$215,140, representing 0.2% of the expenditure budget net of bond financing and audit costs, is to be allocated and available to support the Controller's Audit Fund, pursuant to Charter Appendix F1.113; and ~~\$40,094~~ \$40,604, representing 0.05% of gross bond proceeds is to be allocated and available to support the Public Utilities Commission Revenue Bond Oversight Committee, pursuant to Administrative Code Section 5A.31. These appropriations may be increased or decreased by the Controller based on changes to expenditure appropriations or actual gross bond proceeds to conform to the applicable Charter and Administrative Code formulas.

Section 4: ~~\$80,188,402~~ \$81,208,402 of the total appropriation is hereby placed on Controller's Appropriation Reserve by project. Release of appropriation reserves by the

1 Controller is subject to the prior occurrence of: 1) the SFPUC's and the Board of Supervisors'  
 2 discretionary adoption of CEQA findings for projects, following review and consideration of  
 3 completed project-related environmental analysis, where required, pursuant to CEQA, the  
 4 State CEQA Guidelines, and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code, and 2) the  
 5 Controller's certification of funds availability, including proceeds of indebtedness including  
 6 Commercial Paper capacity.

7 Section 5: Associated Bond financing costs up to ~~\$15,438,198~~ \$15,352,454 is also  
 8 hereby appropriated, including but not limited to, issuance costs, debt service reserve,  
 9 capitalized interest, rating agency, and disclosure costs, all on Controller's reserve pending  
 10 receipt of bond proceeds. To the extent that net available bond proceeds after financing costs  
 11 are more than budgeted, the Controller may approve the use of such surplus bond proceeds  
 12 as a substitute for other sources budgeted in this appropriation.

13 Section 6: The Controller is authorized to record transfers between funds and adjust  
 14 the accounting treatment of sources and uses appropriated in this ordinance as necessary to  
 15 conform to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

4 representing 0.05% of gross bond proceeds is to be allocated and available to support the  
5 Public Utilities Commission Revenue Bond Oversight Committee, pursuant to Administrative  
6 Code Section 5A.31. These appropriations may be increased or decreased by the Controller  
7 based on changes to expenditure appropriations or actual gross bond proceeds to conform to  
8 the applicable Charter and Administrative Code formulas.

9 Section 10: \$92,546,979 of the total bond funded appropriation is hereby placed on  
10 Controller's Appropriation Reserve by project. Release of appropriation reserves by the

13 completed project-related environmental analysis, where required, pursuant to CEQA, the

15 Controller's certification of funds availability, including proceeds of indebtedness including  
16 Commercial Paper capacity, and \$3,000,000 of the GoSolarSF appropriation is placed on Budget &  
17 Finance Committee reserve.

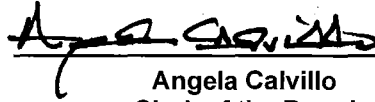

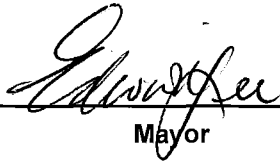
