RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person(s) to serve as member(s) of the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1105 of the San Francisco Municipal Code (Health Code) for the term specified:

Steven Medberry, succeeding himself, (Seat No. 18, must represent Public Utilities Commission), for a new four-year term ending July 1, 2000.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 2. Applicant Steven Medberry, an appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him to serve on the Hazardous Materials Advisory Board.
- 3. The Hazardous Materials Advisory Board has attempted to fill the position, for which Steven Medberry was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific

experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Steven Medberry is qualified to serve on the Hazardous Materials Advisory Board.

4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Hazardous Materials Advisory Board at this time; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Steven Medberry, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
