2 APPOINTING MEMBER(S) TO THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS ADVISORY COMMITTEE;  
3 WAIVING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT.

4 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County  
5 of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated  
6 person(s) to serve as member(s) of the Hazardous Materials Advisory  
7 Committee, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1105 of the San  
8 Francisco Municipal Code (Health Code) for the term specified:

9  
10 Steven Medberry, succeeding himself, (Seat No. 18, must  
11 represent Public Utilities Commission), for a new four-year term  
12 ending July 1, 2000.

13  
14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the  
15 following findings:

- 16 1. The membership of the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee  
17 has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City  
18 and County of San Francisco.
- 19 2. Applicant Steven Medberry, an appointee, who is not a  
20 resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that  
21 uniquely qualifies him to serve on the Hazardous Materials  
22 Advisory Board.
- 23 3. The Hazardous Materials Advisory Board has attempted to fill  
24 the position, for which Steven Medberry was nominated, with  
25 an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific

1 experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable  
2 to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified  
3 that Steven Medberry is qualified to serve on the Hazardous  
4 Materials Advisory Board.

- 5 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors  
6 concludes that there is no other possible representative who  
7 is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific  
8 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this  
9 applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Hazardous  
10 Materials Advisory Board at this time; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the  
12 residency requirement for Steven Medberry, as allowed in cases where  
13 no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant  
14 to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s)  
15 appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by  
16 legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the  
17 City and County of San Francisco.




