

1 **AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING**
2 **TRAFFIC TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND UP TO \$3,986,000 IN STATE**
3 **TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (STIP) FUNDS FOR THE**
4 **CONSTRUCTION OF CESAR CHAVEZ STREET IMPROVEMENTS, FROM MISSISSIPPI**
5 **STREET TO STATE ROUTE 101:**

6 **WHEREAS**, In the 1998 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) adopted by the
7 Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and approved by the State of California
8 Transportation Commission (CTC), the Department of Parking and Traffic has been awarded
9 \$3,986,000 in STIP funds for the construction of bicycle and pedestrian improvements within the
10 Cesar Chavez Circle at U.S. 101 and the installation of a new traffic signal at the intersection of
11 Cesar Chavez Street at Connecticut Street; and

12 **WHEREAS**, The application for and acceptance of these funds has been approved by the
13 Parking and Traffic Commission pursuant to its Resolution Number 174-99-PTC, adopted October
14 19, 1999; and

15 **WHEREAS**, The State funding portion will cover up to 100 percent of eligible costs, as
16 defined and administered by the California Department of Transportation; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Indirect costs will be funded by the grant according to the State Department
18 of Transportation Rules and Regulations; and

19 **WHEREAS**, The Board of Supervisors has adopted Resolution No. 273-97 on March 24,
20 1997, approving the project development and engineering design work; and

21 **WHEREAS**, The Department of Public Works will advertise, award and administer the
22 construction contract to completion, on behalf of the Department of Parking and Traffic; and

23 **WHEREAS**, The above improvements will improve the east-west bicycle and pedestrian
24 circulation through the Cesar Chavez Street Circle at U.S. 101 and traffic flow and provide

1 congestion relief on Cesar Chavez Street, from Connecticut Street to Evans Avenue; and now,
2 therefore, be it


3 **RESOLVED**, That the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic is




