[Firearm Child Safety Devices]

URGING THE CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATURE AND GOVERNOR DAVIS TO APPROVE SENATE BILL 130 AND ASSEMBLY BILL 106 RELATING TO FIREARM CHILD SAFETY DEVICES.

WHEREAS, Current law does not require that guns be sold with child-safety locking devices; and,

WHEREAS, The California State Legislature is currently considering Assembly Bill 106, which was introduced by Assembly Members Scott and Aroner, and Senate Bill 130, which was introduced by Senator Hayden; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 106 would establish the Aroner-Scott Child Gun Accident Prevention Act of 1999; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 106 would require the California Department of Justice to publish a list of approved child-safety lock devices; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 106 would require California-based gun manufacturers, as well as dealers who import guns from out of state, to equip firearms with approved child-safety lock devices prior to sale to the public by any licensed gun dealer; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 106 would mandate that no firearm could be sold without an approved child-safety lock device; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 130 would also prohibit gun dealers from selling firearms without child-safety lock devices; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 130 would require that child-safety lock devices be reusable; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 106 and Senate Bill 130 are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 990222; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors endorses Assembly Bill 106 and Senate Bill 130 and urges the Legislature and Governor to approve this legislation; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from San Francisco in the State Legislature, as well as Governor Davis, with a request they take all action necessary to achieve the objectives of this resolution.
