
On November 28, 2017, Supervisor Kim introduced the following proposed legislation:

[Underground District - Second Street]

Ordinance creating Underground District No. 361 on Second Street from Bryant Street to Townsend Street; and affirming the Planning Department’s determination under the California Environmental Quality Act.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board of Supervisors affirms this determination.

Section 2. Following a public hearing on May 24, 2017, on June 22, 2017, the Department of Public Works issued Order No. 186045 approving the establishment of an underground district on Second Street between Bryant and Townsend streets. Said Order is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____.

Section 3. In accordance with the provisions of Sections 900 et seq. of Article 18 of the Public Works Code, the Board of Supervisors does hereby create the following underground district:

Underground District No. 361

Second Street

District covering Second Street from the northwesterly line of Bryant Street to the northwesterly line of Townsend Street.

Section 4. The undergrounding of utility facilities within this underground district is in the general public interest because it will eliminate a heavy concentration of overhead wires. The construction of the Second Street Improvement Project presents an opportune time to underground the utility facilities in this district.

Section 5. All work in connection with the undergrounding of utility facilities lying within this underground district is to be completed in accordance with the Public Works undergrounding program and is subject to the laws related to the establishment and completion of underground districts contained in Article 18 of the Public Works Code. Such work shall be commenced and completed at such times and in such stages as the Department of Public Works shall establish.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
