3 **Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type 48 on-sale general public**  
4 **premises liquor license to Peter Acworth for The Armory Club, located at 290-292**  
5 **- 14th Street (aka 1799 Mission Street) (District 6), will serve the public**  
6 **convenience or necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco,**  
7 **in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions**  
8 **Code, with conditions.**

10 WHEREAS, Peter Acworth is seeking the issuance of a Type 48 on-sale general  
11 public premises liquor license for The Armory Club, located at 290-292 - 14th Street  
12 (aka 1799 Mission Street); and,

13 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly  
14 zoned and recommends approval; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license  
16 application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business  
18 and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San  
19 Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 48  
20 on-sale general public premises liquor license at 290-292 - 14th Street (aka 1799  
21 Mission Street), to Peter Acworth for The Armory Club, will serve the public  
22 convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

23 Conditions: (1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be  
24 permitted only between the hours of 12 noon – 2:00 am daily. (2) The front door(s)  
25 shall be kept closed after 7:00 p.m. while the privileges of the license area being

1 exercised, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) not to  
2 consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. (3) No noise shall be audible  
3 beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s) as defined on the ABC-257. (4)  
4 The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.  
5 (5) Petitioner shall not make structural changes in the premises interior without prior  
6 written approval from the Department. (6) No person under the age of 21 years of age  
7 shall enter or remain in this public premises. (7) The petitioner shall utilize electronic  
8 surveillance and recording equipment that is able to view inside and outside the  
9 premises and that is actively maintained and recorded. This electronic surveillance  
10 shall be in place during operating hours. Said electronic recording shall be kept up to  
11 (72) hours and shall be made available to the Department or Police Department upon  
12 demand.
