Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to retroactively accept and expend a California Department of Public Health administered grant in the amount of \$1,098,202 for the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission share of an San Francisco Public Utilities Commission/East Bay Municipal Utility District Intertie Project.

WHEREAS, On April 8, 2003, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC), as part of Resolution 03-00062, approved the Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) between the SFPUC, the East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) and the City of Hayward for the design and construction of the SFPUC / EBMUD Intertie Facility ("Intertie Facility"); and

The SFPUC and the EBMUD, with the cooperation of the City of Hayward, agreed to connect their respective water supply systems by jointly constructing and operating the proposed pumping station and related water pipelines.

Specific objectives of the project, which incorporate the individual agency's mission statements, included:

 Providing redundancy and reliability to the regional system in the event of an emergency;

 Reducing direct and indirect costs to customers associated with increased regional system redundancy and reliability;

Planning, designing, constructing and operating intertie facilities

Project Outcome:

The Intertie Facility provides water during emergencies and allows the water transmission lines to be shut down for extended periods for maintenance, inspection and repairs, without causing undue disruption of water deliveries to the City of Hayward and to the ACWD. Similarly, the Intertie Facility allows the EBMUD to receive water from the SFPUC,

	should facilities in their service area be damaged by seismic or other events, or when their critical or related facilities are taken out of service for inspection and maintenance.
	The facility was substantially completed and put in service on September 7, 2007. The project is currently in litigation to address claims submitted by the contractor. The City of Hayward managed the construction and is leading the litigation efforts with assistance from SFPUC and EBMUD legal departments.
	Section 10.170 of the San Francisco Administrative Code permits the application for federal, state, or other grants upon the approval of the department head. Section 10.170-1 of the San Francisco Administrative Code further states that the acceptance and expenditure of Federal, State or other grant funds is subject to the approval by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.
Schedule:	The project was substantially completed and put in service on September 7, 2007. California Department of Public Health Grant funds were awarded to EBMUD March 29, 2010 and distributed to SFPUC on January 14, 2011.
Result of Inaction:	SFPUC must return the Grant funds.
Budget and Costs:	The Water System Improvement Program, Project No. CUW38901 SFPUC/EBMUD Intertie Project is still open. The construction cost of the project was \$17,413,000. The SFPUC fifty percent (50%) share of that cost was \$8,706,500.
