3 **Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks"**
4 **by adding thereto Section 1564 to change the official sidewalk width on the west side**
5 **of Lyon Street at Chestnut Street; making findings pursuant to the General Plan and**
6 **Planning Code Section 101.1; and requiring relocation, modification, or both of**
7 **facilities affected by the sidewalk width changes.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference
14 herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letter
15 dated August 21, 2003, which stated that the actions contemplated herein are consistent with
16 the General Plan and in conformance with the Eighth Priority Policies of Planning Code
17 Section 101.1. A copy of such letter is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No.
18 041115.

19 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No. 174,891, a
20 copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 041115, Board of
21 Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks," a copy of
22 which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect
23 May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

24 Section 1564. The width of sidewalks on the west side of Lyon Street at Chestnut
25 Street shall be as shown on Department of Public Works drawing Q-20-562, a copy of which
is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 041115.

1 Section 3. The Presidio Trust, as is necessary as a result of this Ordinance, shall
2 make arrangements with public utility companies and City departments concerning relocation,
3 modification, or any affected public facilities. Any required relocation, modification, or both of
4 said facilities shall be at no cost to the City and County of San Francisco.

5 Section 4. The Presidio Trust agrees and represents that the project entrance depicted
6 in drawing Q-20-562 is not intended to be used for vehicular access, except as necessary in
7 the case of an emergency.




