7 hereby appoint the following designated persons to serve as members of the Citizen’s
8 Committee on Community Development, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 212-09
9 for the terms specified:

10 Charlie Sciammas, seat 1, new appointment, should reflect and advance the concerns
11 and needs of low-income neighborhoods and/or communities in the City. No person who is
12 either employed by or serves on the governing board of any entity that has a CDBG or ESG
13 grant application pending with the City shall be eligible to serve as a member, for a one-year
14 term to be determined.

15 Rene Cazenave, seat 2, new appointment, should reflect and advance the concerns
16 and needs of low-income neighborhoods and/or communities in the City. No person who is
17 either employed by or serves on the governing board of any entity that has a CDBG or ESG
18 grant application pending with the City shall be eligible to serve as a member, for a one-year
19 term to be determined.

20 Joshua Arce, seat 3, new appointment, should reflect and advance the concerns and
21 needs of low-income neighborhoods and/or communities in the City. No person who is either
22 employed by or serves on the governing board of any entity that has a CDBG or ESG grant
23 application pending with the City shall be eligible to serve as a member, for a two-year term to
24 be determined.

1 Gaylen Mohre, seat 4, new appointment, should reflect and advance the concerns and
2 needs of low-income neighborhoods and/or communities in the City. No person who is either
3 employed by or serves on the governing board of any entity that has a CDBG or ESG grant
4 application pending with the City shall be eligible to serve as a member, for a two-year term to
5 be determined.
