2 AUTHORIZING THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM TO ACCEPT  
3 AND EXPEND A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE  
4 MANAGEMENT BOARD OF UP TO \$300,000.00 IN THE FISCAL YEAR  
5 2000 - 2001 AND CONTINUE TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND RECURRING  
6 GRANT FUNDING AWARDED ANNUALLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
7 INCREASING USED MOTOR OIL RECYCLING AND HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS  
8 WASTE MANAGEMENT.

11 WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have  
12 enacted the California Oil Recycling Enhancement Act that  
13 provides funds to cities and counties for establishing and  
14 maintaining local used oil collection programs that  
15 encourage recycling or appropriate disposal of used oil;  
16 and,  
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18 WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management  
19 Board has been delegated the responsibility for the  
20 administration of the program with the state, setting up  
21 necessary procedures governing application by cities and  
22 counties under the program; and,  
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1 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco will  
2 enter into an agreement with the State of California for  
3 implementation of used oil collection programs; and,

4 WHEREAS, the grant terms prohibit including indirect  
5 costs in the grant budget; and

6 WHEREAS, the grant is a non-competitive grant that is  
7 available to the City and County of San Francisco from the  
8 California Integrated Waste Management Board; now,  
9 therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco  
11 authorizes the submittal of grant applications to the  
12 California Integrated Waste Management Board for all  
13 available grants under the California Oil Recycling  
14 Enhancement Act and all available HHW grants under the  
15 California Integrated Waste Management Act; and be it  
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17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Solid Waste  
18 Management Program, or the designee, is hereby authorized  
19 and empowered to execute in the name of the City and County  
20 of San Francisco all necessary applications, contracts,  
21 payment and carry out the purposes specified in the grant  
22 application; and be it  
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
FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby




