

1 [Suspend 30 Day Rule - Repetitive Ballot Initiatives]
2 SUSPENDING RULE 5.43 OF THE RULES OF ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
3 SUPERVISORS TO ALLOW THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO CONSIDER, WITHOUT
4 WAITING 30 DAYS AFTER ITS INTRODUCTION, PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT
5 THAT WOULD INCREASE THE NUMBER OF REQUIRED SIGNATURES TO PLACE
6 REPETITIVE INITIATIVES ON THE BALLOT.

8 WHEREAS, Rule 5.43 of the Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors requires that
9 when a measure is introduced that would create or revise major City policy, the measure shall
10 not be considered until at least 30 days after the day of the measure's introduction; and,

11 WHEREAS, Rule 4.38 of the Rules of order of the Board allows 5.43 to be suspended
12 by the affirmative vote of eight members of the Board, unless there be less than eight
13 members present, in which case the unanimous consent of the members present, but not less
14 than six members, shall be required; and,

15 WHEREAS, The members of the Board of Supervisors wish to suspend the operation
16 of Rule 5.43 with regard to the consideration of File #991983, repetitive ballot initiatives
17 charter amendment; now, therefore, be it

18 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, as
19 allowed by Rule 4.38 of its Rules of Order, hereby suspends the operation of Rule 5.43 of its
20 Rules of orders from operating with regard to the Board's consideration of a proposed charter
21 amendment that would increase the number of required signatures to place repetitive
22 initiatives on the ballot.


