

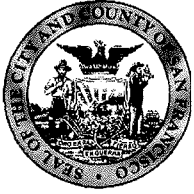
[Mayoral Reappointment, Public Utilities Commission - Kate Stacy]

Motion approving the Mayor's nomination for the reappointment of Kate Stacy to the Public Utilities Commission, term ending August 1, 2030.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Charter, Section 4.112, Mayor Daniel Lurie has submitted a communication notifying the Board of Supervisors of the nomination for the reappointment of Kate Stacy to seat 4 on the Public Utilities Commission, received by the Clerk of the Board on June 5, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Charter, Section 4.112, requires that seat 4 shall be a member with expertise in water systems, power systems or public utility management, appointed by the Mayor and subject to confirmation by a majority of the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Mayor's nomination for the reappointment of Kate Stacy, seat 4, succeeding herself, to the Public Utilities Commission, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term beginning August 1, 2026, and ending August 1, 2030.
