

1 AUTHORIZING THE SAN FRANCISCO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO ACCEPT  
2 AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,840 FROM THE CALIFORNIA  
3 ENERGY COMMISSION TO REDUCE PEAK LOAD AT HARRY TRACY WATER TREATMENT  
4 PLANT.

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6 WHEREAS, the state of California is experiencing an energy  
7 shortage; and

8 WHEREAS, water and wastewater treatment plants are large  
9 consumers of energy during peak times between 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.; and,

10 WHEREAS, the California Energy Commission is offering grants to  
11 the state's water and wastewater facilities to reduce their energy  
12 consumption at peak times; and,

13 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission has  
14 identified and is ready to implement three projects to reduce energy  
15 consumption by 73,555 kilowatt hours per year at Harry Tracy Water  
16 Treatment Plant; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That all of the direct and indirect costs will be  
18 covered by this grant; now, therefore, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Public  
20 Utilities Commission authorized the General Manager to request the  
21 Board of Supervisors to accept and expend the grant in the amount of  
22 \$75,840 from the California Energy Commission; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approve that the  
24 San Francisco Public Utilities Commission accept and expend a grant


