4 **recommendations of the Shelter Monitoring Committee without further delay.**

6 WHEREAS, There should be equal treatment and access for all shelter clients; and

7 WHEREAS, All shelter clients should have access to shelters and a basic standard of
8 care, including hygiene, access, safety, and Americans with Disabilities; and,

9 WHEREAS, More than one thousand people in SF currently access the shelter system;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, A standard of care would offer a consistent service baseline across the
12 City for shelters and resource centers; and

13 WHEREAS, Shelter and resource centers are the first points of access to the homeless
14 and housing service programs and should reflect the City's intention to offer aid; now,
15 therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Human Services Agency to
17 immediately implement the recommendations of the Shelter Monitoring Committee without
18 further delay.
