11	WHEREAS, The human rights of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT)
12	people are firmly embedded into international human rights conventions; and
13	WHEREAS, State leaders are often responsible for fostering a climate of hostility in
14	which people suspected of being lesbian, gay, bisexual or transgender are routinely subjected
15	to harassment, discrimination and violence; and
16	WHEREAS, Many of those who speak up for LGBT rights—regardless of their sexual
17	orientation—become the targets and victims of threats and persecution; and
18	WHEREAS, In many instances, the police and other agents of the state are the
19	perpetrators of human rights abuses, such as extortion, entrapment and physical assaults;
20	and
21	WHEREAS, Reprehensible acts of hate speech and hate crimes targeting the LGBT
22	community have historically, and continue to occur in and around the Bay Area; now,
23	therefore, be it

2	hereby strongly condemns hate-motivated violence directed against Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual
3	and Transgender individuals and further urging all legal authorities to guarantee that all such

6	FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors urges the US government to
7	give equal consideration to violations based on sexual orientation and gender identity in
8	reporting and formulating policies around the promotion of global human rights.
