7 WHEREAS, The San Francisco International Airport (the "Airport") is constructing a
8 new cargo facility, referred to as North Field Cargo Building I, which is scheduled for
9 completion in the fall 2000; and,

10 WHEREAS, Airport staff has negotiated a Lease with Korean Air Lines, Ltd., for
11 warehouse and office space in the North Field Cargo Building I; and,

13 WHEREAS, On June 6, 2000, pursuant to Resolution No. 00-0211, the Airport
14 Commission approved the Lease with Korean Air Lines, Ltd. A copy of the form of the Lease is
15 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001245; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Five Year, Three
17 Month Lease for cargo warehouse and office space in the North Field Cargo Building I, between
18 Korean Air Lines, Ltd., and the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and through its
19 Airport Commission.




