WHEREAS, One of the missions of the San Francisco Library is to provide resources to City residents which assist them in their daily lives; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco has many programs to encourage revitalization of neighborhoods, home ownership, beautification of property, and building community businesses; and

WHEREAS, Many San Francisco residents, community groups and small businesses do not have the resources available to them to undertake home repair, community rebuilding or other improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Library should assist communities with both the knowledge necessary for such improvements but also with the tools to undertake such projects; and

WHEREAS, A Tool Lending Library allows residents with a library card to borrow, for a few days, various home repair and gardening tools they otherwise would not be able to afford; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco residents would greatly benefit from access to tools such as weed-eaters, demolition hammers, ladders, cement mixers, saws, drills and plumbing snakes to help build and improve their homes, businesses and neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, The City of Berkeley has successfully run a Tool Lending Library since 1979 and now has over 2,500 tools for use by its residents; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco has the resources needed to implement a similar Tool Lending Library program for its residents; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors supports the creation of a Tool Lending Library in the City of San Francisco; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board Supervisors urges the San Francisco Library and the Mayor to include funding in the City's Fiscal Year 1999-2000 budget for a neighborhood "Tool Lending Library."
