3 **Resolution supporting the Teamster workers engaged in a labor dispute with their**
4 **employer, Flying Food Group, which provides food service to airlines at the San**
5 **Francisco International Airport.**

7 WHEREAS, Members of Teamsters Local 2785 are employed as truck drivers and
8 helpers at Flying Food Group and the San Francisco International Airport (SFO); and

9 WHEREAS, These workers are responsible for performing their duties responsibly and
10 with punctuality to ensure seamless and safe operations at SFO; and

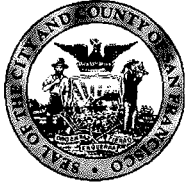
11 WHEREAS, These workers have been on strike since the beginning of April in an effort
12 to maintain adequate economic security and affordable health care for themselves and their
13 families; and

14 WHEREAS, Flying Food Group, has not offered economic compensation to adequately
15 meet the expectations of these workers, nor have they been negotiating in good faith, which in
16 turn has prolonged this labor dispute; and

17 WHEREAS, San Francisco and SFO have a history of labor harmony and peace
18 provisions in contracts, support for airport workers, support for workers exercising their
19 autonomy over their own labor, and strong public policies to support worker protections; now,
20 therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
22 hereby recognizes the essential and difficult work performed by members of Teamsters Local
23 2785 at Flying Foods; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the
2 parties to immediately resume good faith bargaining so that these workers can return to work
3 with dignity and economic security.

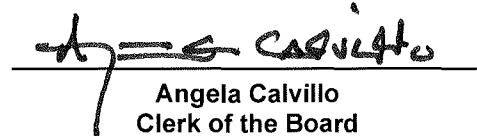

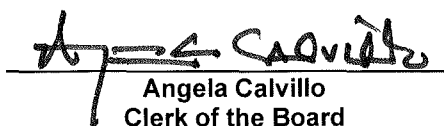
