At its in-person meeting on Monday, December 15, 2025 the Youth Commission discussed and took action on BOS File No. 251197:

1. The Youth Commission positively recommends this piece of legislation to the full Board of Supervisors and Mayor's Office.
2. The Youth Commission also inquired about the following:
 - How will the women who were affected be supported by the City and County of San Francisco?
 - What are the support systems for women who were affected and why is there no oversight being administered by the Sheriff's Oversight Council?
 - What is the capacity for the Department of Police Accountability when it comes to addressing this issue?
 - Were the deputies held accountable during the multiple incidents reported?
 - Why are we only hearing about this incident now?
 - What are more efficient ways to hold the Sheriff's Department accountable?
 - How do we eliminate bias when overlooking/addressing these incidents?
 - Will this trigger further investigations with the Sheriff's conduct, not just in women's jails but also in Juvenile Hall and other institutions under the Sheriff's Department?
 - If there was already an alternate option for strip-searching, why are strip-searches still being used at all?
 - Why aren't they women deputies conducting strip searches for other women?
