[Charter Amendment - Naming Airport - Harvey Milk San Francisco International Airport]

Charter Amendment (First Draft) to amend the Charter, Sections 4.1115 and 16.104, naming the airport the Harvey Milk San Francisco International Airport.

Existing Law

The name of the airport for the City and County of San Francisco is the San Francisco International Airport.

Amendments to Current Law

This Charter amendment would make the official name of the airport the Harvey Milk San Francisco International Airport. The Charter amendment would also make non-substantive grammatical changes to section 4.115.

Background Information

This Charter amendment would not change the airport's three-letter identifier (SFO). The Federal Aviation Administration, not the City, has authority to set the three-letter identifier.
