11 WHEREAS, Le Petit Paris 75 LLC, is seeking the issuance of a Type-90 on-sale
12 general music venue liquor license to do business as Paname SF, located at 523
13 Broadway Street (District 3); and

14 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
15 zoned and recommends approval; and

16 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero protests and zero letters of
17 support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business
18 and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of
19 Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

20 WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the
21 following: 1) Except as provided in Condition 2 below, no noise shall be audible beyond

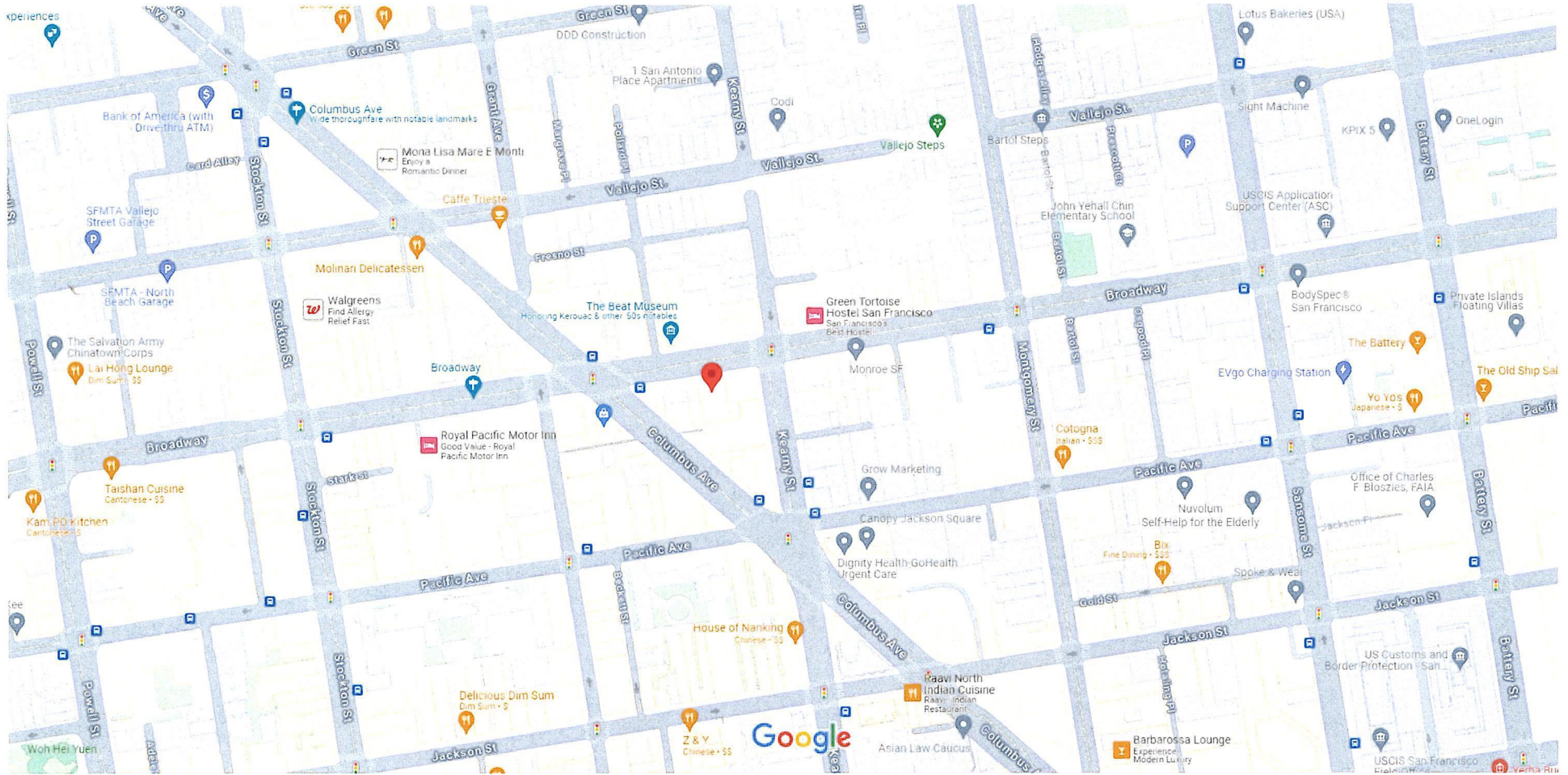

I am writing to express support for the futur establishment called Paname in North beach, San Francisco and to make a determination regarding its classification as a Public Convenience or Necessity (PCN). The purpose of this determination is to assess the potential benefits the club would bring to the community.

Paname is the slang name of Paris in France. Everyone in France know Paris as "Paname" especially Parisian like me. Paname is gonna be the big sister of the french bar/restaurant called le petit Paris 75 that I opened 4 years ago right before Covid which is located right next door at 515 Broadway. Paname

will be a bigger space and will be a hybrid club that will offer a diverse range of entertainment, including comedy shows, magic shows, drag shows, French cabaret show (similar to Moulin rouge in Paris), live bands, and DJs. This establishment aims to serve the public convenience and necessity in both the neighborhood and citywide by fostering cultural enrichment, community engagement, and providing a unique entertainment experience.

****Security and Safety Protocols:****

Paname will prioritize the safety of its patrons and neighbors by implementing robust security protocols. This includes hiring trained security personnel, monitoring the premises to deter any unwanted behavior, and collaborating with local law enforcement to address any safety concerns promptly.

At least 2 security guard will permanent be outside

1 checking ID and 2nd will monitor the line and the crowd waiting outside.

4 guard will be inside on each corner of the venue + 1 floating around inside and outside

****Community Engagement and Open Communication:****

The club is committed to establishing open lines of communication with its neighbors to address any concerns proactively. Regular community meetings and feedback sessions will be organized to ensure that neighbors have a platform to express their opinions, allowing for a collaborative approach in addressing potential issues

****Soundproofing and Acoustic Measures:****

Paname is committed to implementing state-of-the-art soundproofing and acoustic measures within the establishment. This includes the installation of sound-absorbing materials, acoustic panels, and other technologies designed to contain sound within the club premises. These measures aim to create an immersive and vibrant atmosphere inside the club without causing any noise pollution outside.
