

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - U.S. Department of Justice 2009 COPS Technology
2 Initiative for the Expansion of a Gunshot Location System Project - \$1,000,000]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Chief of Police for the City and County of San**
4 **Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of**
5 **\$1,000,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Community**
6 **Oriented Policing Services for expansion of a gunshot location system**
7 **project.**

9 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police for the City and County of San Francisco
10 desires to undertake a certain project designated “COPS Tech 09-10 Gunshot
11 Location System”, to be funded from funds made available through the U.S.
12 Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS);
13 and

14 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco currently operates a
15 gunshot location system covering 3.3 square miles; and

16 WHEREAS, The expansion proposal would increase gunshot location
17 system coverage by an additional 4 square miles; and

18 WHEREAS, The current gunshot location system reports gunfire at a rate
19 of 692% over citizen reports; and

20 WHEREAS, The current gunshot location system enhances the ability of
21 police management to direct resources to resolve community crime issues; and,

22 WHEREAS, The 2009 COPS Technology Program grant provides
23 \$1,000,000.00 of funding for equipment and installation; and,

1 WHEREAS, The 2009 COPS Technology Program does not require
2 matching funds for this project; and
3 WHEREAS, The 2009 COPS Technology Program does not allow for
4 indirect costs; and
5 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance
6 Amendment; now, therefore, be it
7 RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police for the City and County of San
8 Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to
9 retroactively accept and expend funding for this project from the U.S. Department
10 of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services; and, be it
11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police for the City and County
12 of San Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of
13 San Francisco the necessary Grant Agreement for this project including any
14 extensions, funding augmentations from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of
15 Community Oriented Policing Services, or amendments thereof; and, be it
16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of
17 performance of this Grant Agreement, including civil court actions for damages,
18 shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency; and, be it
19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be
20 used to supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors.
