WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby:

Approves the acceptance and expenditure of \$220,000 for improvements to the trails 1. encasing Pine Lake; and

- 2. Certifies that the City and County of San Francisco Recreation and Park Department are in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement with the California Department of Parks and Recreation;
- 3. Certifies that said applicant has or will have available prior to commencement of any work on the project(s) included in this application, sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project(s); and
- 4. Waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget;
- 5. Appoints the General Manager as agent of the Recreation and Park Department to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to agreements, payment requests, progress reports and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
