

1 [Approval of a 30 day extension for Planning Commission review.]

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3 **Resolution extending by 30 days the prescribed time within which the Planning**  
4 **Commission may render its decision on a proposed Ordinance that would amend**  
5 **Planning Code Sections 725.1 and 725.42 of the Union Street Neighborhood**  
6 **Commercial District to provide for a limited number of new full service restaurants that**  
7 **satisfy specific requirements and obtain conditional use authorization; and making**  
8 **environmental findings and findings of consistence with the General Plan and priority**  
9 **policies of Planning Code Section 101.1.**

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11 WHEREAS, On October 16, 2007, Supervisor Alioto-Pier introduced legislation to  
12 initiate the process amending San Francisco Planning Code Sections 725.1 and 725.42 of the  
13 Union Street Neighborhood Commercial District to permit up to 10 new full service restaurants  
14 that satisfy specific requirements and obtain conditional use authorization, and making  
15 findings, including environmental findings and findings of consistency with the priority policies  
16 of Planning Code Section 101.1 and the General Plan. A copy of said legislation is on file  
17 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 071425 and is incorporated herein by  
18 reference; and,

19 WHEREAS, On or about October 25, 2007, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors  
20 referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the  
21 proposed ordinance; and,

22 WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by  
23 resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its  
24 decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code that the Board of Supervisors  
25 initiates; and,

1           WHEREAS, additional time to review the proposed ordinance is needed in order to  
2 enable Supervisor Alioto-Pier and the Planning Department to engage in outreach with the  
3 Union Street Neighborhood Commercial District community organizations and neighbors; and,

4           WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning  
5 Commission additional time to review the proposed ordinance and render its decision; now  
6 therefore be it

7           RESOLVED, That by this resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time  
8 within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed ordinance for  
9 an additional 30 days, or until February 22, 2008.

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
