

1 [Airport Professional Services Agreement Modification - Vanderlande Industries Inc. -
2 Operate, Maintain and Repair Airport-Owned Passenger Boarding Bridges and Baggage
3 Handling Systems - Not to Exceed \$13,646,492]

4 **Resolution approving Modification No. 2 to Airport Contract No. 50030.01,**
5 **Vanderlande Industries Inc., to increase the contract amount by \$3,852,617 for a new**
6 **not to exceed contract amount of \$13,646,492 to operate, maintain, and repair**
7 **Airport-owned passenger boarding bridges and baggage handling systems in the**
8 **domestic terminals; and to exercise the final one-year option to extend the term from**
9 **October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2021, pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118(b).**

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11 WHEREAS, On July 19, 2016, the Airport Commission approved Resolution No. 16-
12 0206, and amended on August 9, 2016, by Resolution No. 16-0222 awarding the operation,
13 maintenance and repair of Airport owned passenger boarding bridges (PBB) and baggage
14 handling systems (BHS) in the domestic terminals Contract No. 50030.01 to Vanderlande
15 Industries Inc., for a three-year and one month period beginning September 1, 2016,
16 through September 30, 2016, in an amount not to exceed \$5,397,000, with up to two (2)
17 one-year options, exercisable at the sole discretion of the Airport Commission; and

18 WHEREAS, On August 27, 2019, by Resolution No. 19-0180, the Airport
19 Commission approved Modification No. 1 to Contract No. 50030.01 with Vanderlande
20 Industries Inc. to operate, maintain and repair Airport owned PBBs and BHS in the
21 domestic terminals at San Francisco International Airport, exercising the first of two (2) one-
22 year options commencing October 1, 2019, through September 30, 2020, in an amount not
23 to exceed \$4,396,875 for the option period, for a new total not to exceed contract amount of
24 \$9,793,875; and

1 WHEREAS, Vanderlande Industries Inc. has satisfactorily provided all aspects of the
2 operation, maintenance and repair of Airport owned PBBs and BHSs in the domestic
3 terminals, and the contract is set to expire on September 30, 2020; and

4 WHEREAS, A modification to exercise the final 2-year option to extend the
5 agreement is required to retain the operation, maintenance and repair of Airport-owned
6 PBBs and BHSs in the domestic terminals with Vanderlande Industries Inc.; and

7 WHEREAS, On March 16, 2020, by Resolution No. 20-0112, the Airport
8 Commission approved Modification No. 2 to Contract No. 50030.01 with Vanderlande
9 Industries Inc. to operate, maintain and repair Airport owned PBBs and BHSs in the
10 domestic terminals at San Francisco International Airport, exercising the second and final
11 of the two (2) 1-year options commencing October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2021, in
12 an amount not to exceed \$3,852,617 for the option period, for a new total not to exceed
13 contract amount of \$13,646,492; and

14 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), provides that agreements entered into by a
15 department, board or commission requiring anticipated expenditures by the City and
16 County of ten million dollars or more, shall be subject to approval by the Board of
17 Supervisors by resolution; and

18 WHEREAS, The original Contract and Modifications are all on file with the Clerk of
19 the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of
20 this Resolution as set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That this Board hereby approves Modification No. 2 to Contract No.
22 50030.01, to increase the contract amount by \$3,852,617 for a new not to exceed contract
23 amount of \$13,646,492; and to exercise the final one-year option to extend the term from
24 October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2021; and, be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of Modification No. 2 being fully

1 executed by all parties, the Airport Commission shall provide it to the Clerk of the Board for
2 inclusion in the official file.

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
