6 WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco has been marketing, promoting and leasing
7 City Hall facilities for banquets, receptions, conventions, corporate events and other special
8 occasions; and

9 WHEREAS, Numerous lavish non-union catered events have been held at City Hall
10 and more are booked through the year 2001 which will deprive union culinary workers of
11 substantial income and potentially threaten their livelihood; and

12 WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco has a proud history of promoting social justice
13 and fair play, and a long standing tradition of support for unions and labor who make up a
14 substantial segment of the City's population, its economy, and tax base; and

15 WHEREAS, Under Governor Davis' administration, the state of California state has
16 now adopted a policy to utilize union labor and unionized facilities during state sponsored
17 events; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
19 urges the City Departments to adopt a policy which utilizes unionized culinary workers and
20 unionized catering establishments from with the City and County of San Francisco during City
21 sponsored banquets, conventions, receptions and other special events.


