Candidate statement of qualifications as to demographic qualities of the City and County of San Francisco
Pursuant to Charter section 4.101(a)1

Candidate: Sabrina Hernandez, Business Representative/Compliance Officer, IBEW Local Union 6

In advocacy for women and minorities; increased diversity in the organized trades; economic justice for women, minorities and youth; pathways to high-skill/high-pay careers:

As a minority woman in an industry dominated by white men (electrical construction) I am both fortunate to have achieved my level of professional success and challenged to create new ways in which I can assist other San Francisco women, minorities and youth to enter and succeed in high-skill, high-pay careers in the organized trades. This is why, throughout my career, I have maintained an active role in community based organizations such as Tradeswomen Inc, and in AFL-CIO constituency organizations such as the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus (EWMC), Pride @ Work, the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW), and the Labor Council for Latin American Advancement (LCLAA), all of which advocate for the rights of women, minorities, and others who may be marginalized at work.

In addition to the aforementioned efforts, I regularly volunteer for the San Francisco Unified School District and with San Francisco non-profit organizations offering pre-apprenticeship training opportunities to SF residents. I work primarily with non-profits whose clients are BIPOC, from disadvantaged economic backgrounds, graduating out of foster care, or are being reintroduced to their communities after recent release from prison.

In efforts to defend the rights of the San Francisco immigrant worker community:

As a business representative and public works contract compliance officer for IBEW Local Union 6, I represent the interests of IBEW members and our management partners; however, much of my work benefits non-unionized immigrant workers in San Francisco, primarily from Russia, China, Korea, Mexico, and Central America. As immigrants, many of whom have limited English language skills, these workers are vulnerable and are often taken advantage of. They may be paid less than the wages required by law, asked to perform work in unsafe conditions, not compensated for overtime, and otherwise abused at work. My position and training allow me to educate these workers on their rights under the law and assist them in seeking remedies through the San Francisco Office of Labor Standards Enforcement and other authorities having jurisdiction.

In addition to my professional work to defend immigrants, I also volunteer for *SF We Rise* – The San Francisco Labor Council Center for Immigrant Justice; and I regularly participate at weekend citizenship workshops conducted through their collaboration on the San Francisco Pathways to Citizenship Initiative. Immigration issues are a top priority for the San Francisco Chapter of the Labor Council for Latin American Advancement (LCLAA) where I am an active member, and for the National Executive Board of LCLAA in Washington, DC, where I serve as the representative for the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, AFL-CIO.

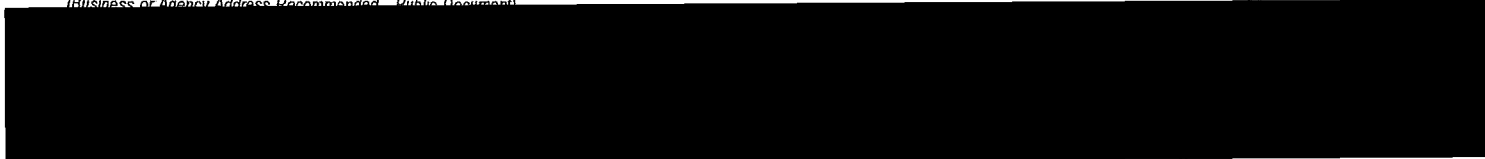





Dear Supervisors Peskin, Chan and Mandelman,

I am writing in support of my brother, Francis (Frank) Gleason for one of the seats on the Golden Gate Bridge Highway and Transportation District. Frank is currently a driver for Golden Gate Transit, and I know that he is uniquely qualified, and San Francisco would be well served, to have Frank be appointed to the Golden Gate Bridge Board. A major function of the Bridge District is having people transverse to and from Marin and San Francisco and handling how that occurs. From San Francisco's standpoint there is also the concern of the impact of this activity.

Frank has been a union driver since the 1980s, first with the Teamsters, and currently with Golden Gate transit. If you want to be able to get around, you ask Frank. Traffic impacts, ask Frank. Who are the people who use and need public transit, ask Frank.

Like Frank, I have been a life-long resident of the inner-Richmond district. I have concerns about impact of Golden Gate Bridge traffic and commuters on my neighborhood. Frank and I grew up in the neighborhood, went to the public schools, raised our own families here, and I know that Frank is committed to ensuring that our public agencies serve everyone.

My own experience with the Board of Supervisors Rules Committee is when I was selected for two terms as the Board of Supervisor's sole appointment to the San Francisco Elections Commission. I served from 2004-2013. At the time, the Rules Committee selected me for my knowledge of public elections – having designed the optical scan ballots for the SF Department of Elections, and after a short stint working for the City, I continued serving as an election day poll worker. I had no connections or "juice". The Rules Committee took a leap of faith. The Elections Department went from chaos to stellar. I served for ten years and missed only 2 meetings during my service. I came to meetings prepared. And after 10 years, someone else was appointed to the Board's seat on the Commission – and that is a good thing.

I am surprised the Golden Gate Bridge District Board of Directors appears to have long-term appointments. I have not heard of new and fresh ideas out of that organization in some time. I live near the bridge and everything seems to be "same old, same old". New perspective and voice are needed.

I know that Frank has to cross that bridge several times a day. Frank has to do that on a schedule. Who on that Board of Directors right now can say that? Right now I work safely from home. But my brother Frank is out there driving people who have no other option than public transit... and Frank does it with a paper mask on. I cannot say more about Frank and commitment than that. Frank is frontline when frontline means something. Please, I know it will be difficult, but I ask that you take that leap, involve new people. Be the change. Appoint my brother Frank to the Golden Gate Bridge Board.
