

1 [Contracting Out Airport Information Booth Services]

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3 **Resolution approving the Controller’s certification that Airport Information Booth**  
4 **Services at San Francisco International Airport can be practically performed by private**  
5 **contractor at a lower cost than in the work were performed by City and County**  
6 **employees.**

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8 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco adopted a new  
9 charter effective July 1, 1996 which in Section 10.104(15) incorporates the provisions of  
10 Proposition “J” adopted November 1976, allowing City Departments to contract with private  
11 companies for specific services; and

12 WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on April 22, 2004, that the services involved in  
13 the management and operation of an Airport Information Booth Program at San Francisco  
14 International Airport can be practically performed by Polaris Research and Development, Inc.  
15 at a lower cost to the City and County of San Francisco than if such services were performed  
16 by employees of the City and County of San Francisco; and

17 WHEREAS, On May 4, 2004 pursuant to Resolution No. 04-0092, the Airport  
18 Commission awarded the Airport Information Booth Program to Polaris/TRG Joint Venture;  
19 now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.104(15) of the Charter, this Board of  
22 Supervisors hereby approves said Controller’s Certification.

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
