3	Resolution authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend a

7	WHEREAS, The Congress under Public Law 88-578 has authorized the establishment
8	of a federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant-In-Aid program, providing Matching
9	funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for acquiring lands and
10	developing Facilities for public outdoor recreation purposes; and
11 12	WHEREAS, The State Department of Parks and Recreation is responsible for
13	administration of the program in the state, setting up necessary rules and procedures
14	governing Application by local agencies under the program; and
15	WHEREAS, Said adopted procedures established by the State Department of Parks
16	and Recreation require the Applicant to certify by resolution the approval of Applications and
17	the availability of eligible Matching funds prior to submission of said Applications to the state;
18	and
19	WHEREAS, The proposed McLaren Park, Yosemite Creek and Marsh Renovation
20	
21	Project is consistent with the Statewide Comprehensive Recreation Resources Plan
22	California Outdoor Recreation Plan - 2002; and
23	WHEREAS, The Project must be compatible with the land use plans of those
24	jurisdictions immediately surrounding Project ;and WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now therefore be it

1	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors authorizes the Recreation
2	and Park Department to accept and expend a grant from the Land and Water Conservation
3	Funds in the Amount of \$154,020 for the renovation of McLaren Park, Yosemite Creek and
5	Marsh; and be it
6	FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby:
7	Approves the filing of an Application for Land and Water Conservation Fund assistance; and
8	Certifies that said agency has Matching funds from the following source(s): San_Francisco
9	Recreation & Park Department Open Space Fund and can finance 100 percent of the Project
10	half of which will be reimbursed; and Waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget;
11 12	and Certifies that the Project is compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions
13	immediately surrounding the Project; and Appoints the General Manager of the Recreation
14	and Park Department as agent to conduct all negotiations and execute and submit all
15	documents, including, but not limited to, Applications, contracts, amendments, payment
16	requests, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned
17	Project.
