9 children in the San Francisco Bay Area; and,

10 WHEREAS, Through its 16 San Francisco Bay Area Centers, Marin
11 Day Schools serves more than 1,400 children between the ages of six
12 weeks and ten years; and,

13 WHEREAS, The care that Marin Day Schools provides is especially
14 important in light of statistics that show a child care crisis facing
15 California, and in particular San Francisco, where there are more
16 than three children waiting for every one child care slot available;

18 WHEREAS, Marin Day Schools is committed to providing children
19 with the nurturing, respect, education, and support they rightfully
20 deserve, operating in accordance with their philosophy that what
21 happens to children today affects the future for us as individuals
22 and as a nation; and,

23 WHEREAS, Marin Day Schools was recently selected as the provider
24 to operate the new San Francisco City Hall Child Care Center - the

3 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
4 of San Francisco commends Marin Day Schools on their eighteenth


