- 3 Streets and blocks southeast of Market St and northeast of Second St are as shown on that map, identified as the "Official Map for Sale of the State's Interest," filed in Map Book "W," pg. 45, San Francisco Recorder's office.
- 4 Streets and blocks south of Second St are as shown on Board of Tide Land Commissioners map "Map of the Salt Marsh and Tide Lands and Lands Lying under Water South of Second Street in the City and County of San Francisco," filed in Map Book "W," pages 46 and 47, San Francisco Recorder's office.
