| 13 | WHEREAS, On October 8, 2004, the Sheriff's Department issued a Request for |
| 14 | Proposals for Food Service Operations at the County Jails and as a result of that selection |
| 15 | process, identified as Aramark Correctional Services to receive a contract in the amount of |
| 16 | \$15,227,132 over four years to provide jail food services; now, therefore, be it |
| 17 | RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 9.118 (b) of the Charter, this Board of |
| 18 | Supervisors hereby approves this resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Department to enter into |
| 19 | a contract for jail food services, specifically the contract contained in Board of Supervisors File |
| 20 | No. 050216, dated February 28, 2005, between Aramark Correctional Services and the City |
| 21 | and County of San Francisco, which will require anticipated expenditures by the City and |
| 22 | County of more than ten million dollars over a four year period. |
