

1 [Jail Food Services]
2 **Resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Department to enter into a contract for jail food**
3 **services which will require anticipated expenditures by the City and County of more**
4 **than ten million dollars over a four year period.**

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6 WHEREAS, Section 9.118 (b) of the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco
7 requires that contracts or agreements entered into by a department, board or commission
8 requiring anticipated expenditures of ten million dollars, shall be subject to approval of the
9 Board of Supervisors by resolution; and,

10 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified that jail food services can practically be
11 performed by a private contractor at a lower cost than if work were performed by city
12 employees at budgeted levels pursuant to Charter Section 10.104.15; and,

13 WHEREAS, On October 8, 2004, the Sheriff's Department issued a Request for
14 Proposals for Food Service Operations at the County Jails and as a result of that selection
15 process, identified as Aramark Correctional Services to receive a contract in the amount of
16 \$15,227,132 over four years to provide jail food services; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 9.118 (b) of the Charter, this Board of
18 Supervisors hereby approves this resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Department to enter into
19 a contract for jail food services, specifically the contract contained in Board of Supervisors File
20 No. 050216, dated February 28, 2005, between Aramark Correctional Services and the City
21 and County of San Francisco, which will require anticipated expenditures by the City and
22 County of more than ten million dollars over a four year period.

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
