WHEREAS, the grant is a non-competitive grant that is available to the City and County of San Francisco from the California Integrated Waste Management Board; and

WHEREAS, The grant application includes administrative overhead costs of \$23,815 in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of the Department of the Environment to apply for funding of \$261,961 from the California Integrated Waste Management Board for a Waste Tire Enforcement Grant. The Director of the Department of the Environment, or their designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City and County of San Francisco all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements and amendments hereto for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant application.
