| 16 | WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors have repeatedly expressed their |
| 17 | support for building a 770-mile high speed rail system between San Francisco and Los |
| 18 | Angeles as a safe, reliable, transportation option for Californians; and, |
| 19 | WHEREAS, A high speed rail system environmental, social and technological benefits |
| 20 | are numerous, including decreased dependence on foreign petroleum, decreased energy use, |
| 21 | decreased emissions of air pollutants, decreased suburban sprawl, decreased impacts to |
